

**GENERAL INFORMATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO B.A. / B.SC. / B.COM. 1<sup>st</sup> YEAR (1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER) DEGREE COURSES FOR THE SESSION 2020-2021.**

**1. All admissions are provisional.**

Admission to B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. 1<sup>st</sup> Year (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) Degree Courses can be made through ONLINE process only. Submission of ONLINE APPLICATION FORM can be made through the LINK provided in the College Website [www.rpmcollege.org](http://www.rpmcollege.org) from 11:00 A.M. of 10.08.20 to 11:00 A.M. of 25.08.20. Candidates may follow the direct link [www.rpmcollegeugadmission.org](http://www.rpmcollegeugadmission.org) for making application. Provisional Merit Lists will be published on 25.08.20 (after 4:00 P.M.). Any query (online mode only) regarding Provisional Merit Lists will be entertained up to 12:00 noon of 28.08.20.

**Final Merit lists**, if required for any corrections in the Provisional Merit Lists, will be published on 28.08.20 (after 4:00 P.M.). Otherwise, Provisional Merit Lists will be treated as Final Merit lists.

**Online Admission starts from 01.09.20 (after 4:00 P.M.).**

2. All candidates who have passed H.S. or Equivalent Examinations (General Stream\*\*), in the years 2019 and onwards are eligible to apply, subject to fulfillment of **eligibility criteria** as laid down by C.U. & the College.

\*\* Students passing H.S. or Equivalent Qualifying Examinations from **Open School / Vocational / Distance Mode** are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for Admission in this college.

3. Marks obtained in H.S. or Equivalent Qualifying Examinations in **TOP FOUR** subjects in order of marks **shall be considered to ascertain the "Aggregate Marks \*\*"**

\*\* **For Calculation of Aggregate Marks:**

i) Marks in Compulsory *Environmental Education / Environmental Studies* shall not be taken into account.

ii) However, *Environmental Science* if studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, shall be taken into account.

4. **Applicants for B.A. (Hons) / B.Sc. (Hons & Gen) / B.Com (Hons & Gen) courses must have passed (i) English (100 marks) & (ii) 3 elective subjects in H.S. or Equivalent Qualifying Examinations.**
5. **Applicants for B.A. (Gen) Courses must have passed (i) English (100 marks) (ii) Bengali (100 marks) & (iii) 3 elective subjects in H.S. or Equivalent Qualifying Examinations. In other words, for Admission to B.A. (Gen) Courses Bengali (100 marks) in H.S. or equivalent examination is compulsory.**
6. Before filling in Online Application Form, Students are advised to check the Combinations of subjects as provided by the College.
7. Candidates applying for B.A. /B.Sc. (Hons) Courses in a subject shall have to choose two Generic Electives (GE) out of available combinations. Between these two Generic Electives they have to select one Generic Elective for each Semester (up to 4<sup>th</sup> Semester) with the condition that they have to study each Generic Elective for two Semesters.
8. Candidates applying for B.A. (Gen.) courses shall have to choose one subject combination among the available '3-subject combinations' offered by the College, keeping in mind that the last subject of a '3-subject combination' will be treated as Generic Elective for Semester-I & Semester-II and first two subjects will be treated as Core Courses. For example, if a candidate choose "Philosophy (G)-Bengali (G)-Sanskrit (G)" as his/her subject combination then Sanskrit (G) will be treated his/her Generic Elective for Semester-I & Semester-II and Philosophy (G)-Bengali (G) will be treated his/her Core Courses. **Candidates applying for B.A. (General) courses cannot take Bengali & English as his/her Generic Elective.**
9. Candidates applying for B.Sc. (Gen.) courses shall have to choose one subject combination among the available '3-subject

combinations' offered by the College and all the three subjects will be treated as Core Courses.

10. A Candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Economics if he/she has passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of H.S. Education or its equivalent examination in Mathematics/ Business Mathematics. Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S. (10+2) level from West Bengal Council of H.S. Education are also eligible for admission in the Honours Course in Economics.

11. Applicants have to **upload the scanned images of the following documents (all in .jpg format)** during submission of ONLINE FORMS.

- (i) Recent Colour Photograph (size within 50KB)
- (ii) Signature (size within 50KB)
- (iii) Age Proof (size within 150KB)
- (iv) Mark Sheet of H.S. or Equivalent Examination (size within 150KB)
- (v) Caste Certificate, *if Applicable* (size within 100KB)
- (vi) PWD Certificate, *if Applicable* (size within 100KB)
- (vii) BPL Certificate, *if Applicable* (size within 100KB)
- (viii) Migration Certificate, *if Applicable* (size within 100KB)
- (ix) Registration Certificate, *if Applicable* (size within 100KB)

**All testimonials mentioned in Sl. No. (iii) - (ix) are to be self-attested Photocopy.**

**12. Processing fee:** After complete submission of the Application Form Applicants have to pay application fee of **Rs. 200/-** + Transaction Charges, as applicable, through ONLINE only. Applicants may select any one of the Payment Gateway ATOM / WORLDLINE for making the online transaction. ***Application Forms for which application fees are paid will be processed for preparation of Merit Lists.***

**13. PUBLICATION OF ALL THE LISTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADMISSION PROCESS WILL BE AVAILBLE ON COLLEGE WEB PAGE and/or ADMISSION PORTAL OF OUR COLLEGE.**

14. **Admission:** Merit-listed candidates will be permitted to take Provisional Admission after full payment of requisite Admission fees (See Our College Website/Admission Portal for Admission fees in different subject combination) through Online (a link for payment *will be given at the right sided column of the lists for such candidates in the Tab named as "E-Counseling List" in our Admission Portal and necessary operations must be followed*) within the requisite date and time for different lists in connection with the admission process. No candidates will be admitted if the date and time is over in connection with such lists.

- Documents of Provisionally Admitted Candidates will be verified at College Premises after the commencement of Classes.
- If a Candidate is continuously absent for more than 7 (Seven days) after the commencement of Classes, his/her admission is deemed to be cancelled.
- **Any mistakes from Candidate's part at any stage of online admission will not be considered and for such cases his/her admission will be cancelled and no refund will be provided by the College.**

15. The College Authority reserves the right to cancel any Admission, if detected anomalous on a later date.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION 2020- 21

(Subject to change as per C.U. Circulars, if any)

1. **(a)** All candidates who have passed H.S. or Equivalent Examination (**with pass in English having full marks being not less than 100**) in the Years 2019 & onwards are eligible to apply for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Year (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) of the 3-Year B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. Degree Courses (Honours/General). Candidates passing H.S. / Equivalent Examinations before 2019 are not eligible to apply for Admission.

**(b)** The students who were admitted in B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. (Hons / Gen) 1<sup>st</sup> year (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) class in 2019 in any College or University and did not enroll / enrolled but did not appear at the B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. (Hons / Gen) 1<sup>st</sup> Year (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) Examination-2019 & B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. (Hons / Gen) 1<sup>st</sup> Year (2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) Examination-2020, are eligible to apply, provided they passed the H.S. / Equivalent Examinations in 2019 only.

2. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Honours/General) course, aggregate Marks, obtained at the prequalifying Examination, shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks, secured by a candidate. However, marks in Compulsory Environmental Education / Studies shall not be taken in to account for calculation of aggregate marks (if the subject "Environmental Science" is studies as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks).

3. **A candidate willing to take up Honours Course in a subject** must have obtained at the previous qualifying examination

i) A minimum of **50% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject** at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

ii) A minimum of **55% marks in the subject or related subject** at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

iii) A minimum of **50% marks in aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject** in his / her previous qualifying examination provided all the other clauses are satisfied (i.e. must have passed in the related subject.)

AND that his/her name comes in the merit list prepared for the purpose.

4. However, a Candidate belonging to the **Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes** community willing to take up Honours course in a subject must have obtained a minimum of **40% marks in the subject or the related subject or in the aggregate** at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be,

AND that his/her names comes in the merit list prepared for the purpose.

5. Candidates applying for any Honours or General Courses, have to **pass (both in Theory and Practical, if applicable)** every subject of the Subject-Combination i.e., a Candidate cannot take any subject as his / her Generic Elective or Core- Courses if he / she is failed in any subject, of the

Subject-Combination, which he /she is applying for. **No combination will be allowed if the Candidate has failed in any particular subject of that combination.**

6. A Candidate is not allowed to take up the same subject as an elective one in which he / she has taken Honours. As for example, a candidate is not allowed to take up Mathematics as an elective subject if he / she take Mathematics as an Honours subject.

7. A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading A if he / she had passed the subject(s) under heading B at the previous qualifying examination.

8. Related Subjects for Admission to B.Com. (Honours) and B.Com. (General) Courses

(a) Following subjects be treated as related subjects for admission to B.Com. Honours courses:

Accountancy, Business Economics including Business Mathematics, Business Organization, Mathematics, Business Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Business Studies, Office and Secretarial Practice, Financial Accounting, Elements of Cost Accountancy & Auditing, Book Keeping, Commerce, Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management, Commercial Law and preliminaries of Auditing, Costing and Taxation.

(b) A candidate shall be allowed to take up B.Com. (General) Course if he/she had passed the subject(s) at the previous qualifying examination as mentioned below:

Accountancy/ Business Economics including Business Mathematics/ Business Organization/ Mathematics/ Economics/ Statistics/ Commerce/ Accounts/ Business Studies/ Financial Accounting/ Office and Secretarial Practice/ Elements of Cost Accountancy and Auditing/ Book Keeping/ Business Mathematics/ Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management, Commercial Law and preliminaries of Auditing, Costing and Taxation.

1. All admissions are provisional.
2. Approval of provisional admission is subject to the fulfillment of conditions laid down by University of Calcutta and the College.
3. Admission is liable to cancellation if, at any stage, after admission it is found that the conditions or requirements for the same as laid down by the College and / or University of Calcutta are not satisfied.
4. Admission will be strictly on merit. However, there shall be usual relaxation or reservation for SC / ST and OBC candidates as per Government Rules. 5. Simultaneous admission in more than one institution in any session is against the Rules and Regulations of University of Calcutta. If, after getting admission in the College, a candidate wants to change over to any institution(s), he / she must seek prior permission in writing from the Principal. Otherwise, if the candidate does not have necessary permission from the Principal to that effect the matter may be referred to the authority of University of Calcutta as well as to the Principal / Teacher-in-Charge of the other institution(s) where he / she has taken admission, for taking necessary (legal) action. Under such circumstances, his / her admission in our institution is liable to be cancelled.
